

Stone Wheelers Cycling Club

Approved at the 2005 A.G.M.

1. The Club shall be called Stone Wheelers Cycling Club (formed 1932).
2. Membership to be open to all persons, who will be elected by the Committee.
3. All racing members must be First Claim only.
4. An Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held to which all members may attend.
 - a. The AGM will normally be held in October but an alternative date may be selected by the committee.
5. Subscriptions
 - a. Subscriptions are as arranged each year at the Annual General Meeting.
 - b.
 - i. Juvenile (Boys and Girls under 16 years of age)
 - ii. Junior (Boys and Girls under 18 years of age)
 - iii. Senior (Men and Women of 19 years of age and older)
 - c. Subscriptions are due on January 1st of each year.
 - d. Subscriptions received after 1st September shall include membership for the current year and subsequent year.
 - e. Clubroom charges are as arranged each year at the Annual General Meeting.
6. Management of the Club
 - a. Management of Club business to be carried out by a Committee consisting of: President(s), Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer(s), Secretaries for; Track, Road Race, Time Trials, Press, Social and Coaching.
 - b. The Committee to meet monthly or as required.
 - c. Committee meetings to have 50% plus one member in attendance before decisions can be reached. However, matters discussed can be implemented at a later date by a full Committee.
 - d. Committee members to retire each year but eligible for re-election if they so desire.
 - e. Vacancies on the Committee can be filled by Committee decision.
 - f. Additional Committee members to be elected at the AGM.
7. Club Room Attendance
Points for Club Attendance Trophy:
Present at clubroom 1 point each attendance
Clubroom points to be compiled from the Clubroom subscription book or books if there are two clubrooms. Points to be totalled up to the last Sunday or club night in September of each year.
8. Adherence to Rules
Members must adhere to all rules. The Committee shall have power to expel any member guilty of conduct detrimental to the good of the Club.
9. Extraordinary General Meeting
An extra-ordinary General Meeting may be convened on the signatures of 25% of the membership. The meeting is to be arranged within 14 days of the receipt of the request.
10. Honorary Membership
Life Membership and Honorary Membership are given by the Club for service or cycling of exceptional nature. Nominations for Honorary Membership to be discussed and approved at the A.G.M..
 - a. Life Members to be for the life of the person so honoured.
 - b. Honorary Membership can be discontinued by Committee decision.
11. Second Claim Membership
Second claim membership is by Committee decision only and for social activities only in that second claim members cannot race for the Club as an individual or team member in any type of event.
12. Third Party Insurance
Members carrying Third Party Insurance i.e. C.T.C. or private company need pay Club Subscription only, unless riding track or road events under B.C.F. Rules, when appropriate subscriptions are applicable.
All members on club group rides require some form of Third Party Insurance.

13. Inactive Club Members

14. Mandate
